1. WORDS ARE PHYSICAL AND SPIRITUAL

Key points:

1. Words are physical and spiritual.
2. Jesus said, "The words that I speak to you, they are spirit and they are life."
3. The name of Jesus represents something. The power is in what it represents. The power is not in the written script or composition of the letters.
4. Many people will use the name of Jesus but will have different results. You need to have a personal revelation.
5. You can speak forth the ability that it represents to you.
6. When you speak the Word, something goes forth.
7. A physical word is a container or vessel which transports and transfers what you put inside of it.
8. You mix the Word with faith and manifest life when you speak it.
9. God looks at your heart. He looks at your ability to give life.
10. When you speak forth The Word, your revelation of Jesus Christ will cause it to manifest and it will achieve what it was sent for.

2. SPEAK THE WORD OF GOD

Key Points:

1. It is critical to speak the Word of God because that is how He created heaven and earth.
2. We've been created in His image and likeness, so we have the same ability inside us to speak and let it be.
3. The prerequisite for you to manifest what you speak, is to have the same life form as God. You need to be born again.
4. Then every word will achieve what it was sent for. No words will fall to the ground.
5. When you became born again, you spoke it into existence. It's not possible to become born again without speaking it.
6. Sin cannot separate you from God, although it may have implications in your life.
7. When you believed in righteousness, you became born again.
8. Righteousness means that when God looks at you, He can see no sin. Jesus paid for all your sins.
9. You cannot become born again without speaking it, the rest of God's promises are no different

3. FAITH COMES WITH THE WORD

Key points:

1. Every Word of God that you receive has the ability inside it to achieve what it sets out to do.
2. If you receive a Word of healing, inside it is the life-giving ability of God to manifest that healing.
3. Inside the Word that you receive is the faith that you need. You can't say that you do not have enough faith.
4. That's why the Word says, *"Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God"*.
5. Spending time in the Word of God teaches us to become familiar with reality and with every Word that we receive, embedded in it, is the faith and the ability to manifest that particular Word of God.
6. When you become born again, you receive the Word and in that Word is the ability to produce salvation.
7. You need to receive it in your spirit.
8. The same principle applies to the rest of the Word of God and we need to start applying this principle.

4. YOUR MINDSET DETERMINES WHAT YOU SPEAK

Key points:

1. God deals with each of us in a personal manner.
2. There are only two kinds of people. Those that are born again and those who need to become born again.
3. Let's treat people in such a way that it speaks of the awareness that God created them for a specific purpose, and that He loves them the same way He loves us.
4. Speak life into the people around you, even those who make things difficult and be the one to effect change in their lives.
5. We need to look different to the world in terms of how we treat people.
6. Christ died for us when we never deserved it, not just for us but for every single person around us.
7. When you speak behind people's backs, you are sowing seed. Whatever you shall sow, you shall reap.
8. We need to spend enough time in the Word of God that we have a true picture of who God is and the parameters within which He functions.
