1. THE PERSON OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Key points:

1. We need to establish a relationship with the Holy Spirit. This relationship is an intimate one; it's sensitive, subtle and gentle.
2. The Holy Spirit is sensitive and can be quenched and grieved.
3. If you are quenching the Spirit, there will be things that He will not be able to manifest through your life. It has nothing to do with God judging you.
4. We are fully and 100% righteous. This gift is what you have received. When God looks at you, He sees no sin. That does not mean sin does not have implications.
5. It is significant for us to function in the Supernatural – It's needed to manifest the fullness of the presence of God.
6. The Holy Spirit is a person. The Holy Spirit is not a dove.
7. Love is at the core of manifesting the presence of God.
8. It is impossible to discuss our purpose without speaking about love.
9. God wants you to experience His love in a very personal and intimate way.
10. Romans 5:5 says hope doesn't disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts (spirit) by the Holy Spirit. It's about receiving the love of God inside of you.
11. There's an ability inside you. The rivers of life-giving ability (John 7:38-39).
12. That ability inside you, through the Holy Spirit is enough to change this world.
13. That which is inside you *is* enough to manifest God's presence once activated through the Holy Spirit.

2. THE HOLY SPIRIT BRINGS US THE PRESENCE OF THE FATHER

Key Points:

1. When you receive the Holy Spirit, you receive the love of God – He is the Spirit of truth and reality and God is love.
2. The Holy Spirit will give you a conviction in your heart about how much God loves you.
3. God puts an ability inside of us that we are able to express, not only towards God, but towards the world.
4. It is impossible to love God unless through people.
5. If you start seeing people as the channel for you to love God, everything about your life will change.
6. 1 John 4:17: *“as He is, so are we”*. We are like Him, right now, in this world and we need to manifest Him in this earth.
7. Fear is the number one way in which we grant satan authority over our lives.
8. 1 John 4:18: *“Perfect love casts out fear”*. When we reach spiritual maturity, the love that is in us will bring about a conviction within us that cause us not to fear anything.
9. Nothing can separate you from the nature and ability of God that is within you.
10. Fear coupled with incorrect thought patterns is preventing us from establishing the fullness of God in this earth.
11. The foundation of what the Holy Spirit needs to achieve in and through us, is love.
12. The Holy Spirit delivers the presence of the Father and the Son to us.
13. The only way to be *in* Christ (born again) is through the Holy Spirit.
14. The Holy Spirit is the conduit or channel through which the fellowship with the Father and the Son flows.

3. WHAT THE HOLY SPIRIT WILL DO IN YOU AND THROUGH YOU

Key points:

1. God wants your heart; He can't force anything onto you. Let alone the Holy Spirit with His gentle approach and nature.
2. God is a God of precision. He is very intimate and very personal.
3. God's intention for us is to know everything that He has prepared for us. He reveals that through His Spirit
4. Matthew 6:33 ~ If you manifest His presence, everything else that you want will be in that presence.
5. If you're trying to intellectually figure out what God has prepared for you and what He is expecting you to manifest, you will fail. It was never meant to be intellectual.
6. We might not be there yet, to manifest His fulness, and maybe we do not see it until the day Jesus returns, but we need to strive to manifest His presence to this extent.

4. RECEIVING THE HOLY SPIRIT

Key points:

1. First, you need to believe it. Then you need to receive it. (the Holy Spirit)
2. You need to be filled by the Spirit (like the illustration of the empty coke bottle).
3. To those who believe in and received the Holy Spirit, Jesus referred to the Holy Spirit as the life-giving water that flows from you.
4. There is a receiving process (Acts 8:17) and a certainty (Luke 11:13) that goes hand-in-hand with this.
5. When you ask the Father for the Holy Spirit, you receive the Holy Spirit.
6. The Holy Spirit will be IN you, and UPON you:

In you – The life form of God is in you

Upon you - The anointed, manifested presence of the ability of God through you. This can be affected when you grieve the Holy Spirit.

7. The Spirit of truth, reality, ability, and love all reside inside you. There is a “stirring up” process required.
8. One doesn’t achieve righteousness by living right. You become righteous because you have received the life of God inside of you and a conviction and an understanding that your righteous nature will lead to righteous living. It comes from within.
9. The Holy Spirit is alive inside you, but you need to activate the relationship. Any relationship requires time, effort and interaction.

Scriptures

1 Thessalonians 5:19 (NKJV)

Do not quench the Spirit.

Ephesians 4:30 (NKJV)

And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

Romans 5:17 (NKJV)

For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.)

Romans 8:38-39 (NKJV)

³⁸ For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, ³⁹ nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 5:5 (NKJV)

Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

1 John 4:17 (NKJV)

Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world.

1 John 4:18 (NKJV)

There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.

1 John 1:3 (NKJV)

that which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have fellowship with us; and truly our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NKJV)

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

1 Corinthians 2:9-14 (NKJV)

⁹ But as it is written:

“Eye has not seen, nor ear heard,

Nor have entered into the heart of man

The things which God has prepared for those who love Him.”

¹⁰ But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. ¹¹ For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one

knows the things of God except the Spirit of God. ¹² Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.

¹³ These things we also speak, not in words which man’s wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual. ¹⁴ But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

Matthew 6:33 (NKJV)

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

John 7:38-39 (NKJV)

³⁸ He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.” ³⁹ But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

Acts 8:17 (NKJV)

Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.

Ephesians 5:18 (NKJV)

And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit,

Acts 1:8 (NKJV)

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

Luke 11:13 (NKJV)

If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!”
